- Visit of Roy Henry Vickers Art Gallery, showcasing the art of the well-renowned Canadian First Nations artist.

Day 3: Tofino - Ucluelet

- Breakfast.
- Outdoor educational program focused on coastal rainforest ecosystem or marine biology.
- Drive to Ucluelet, charming town rich in wildlife and rainforest trails.
- Walk the picturesque Lighthouse Loop Trail at the tip of Ucluelet Peninsula. Discover the active lighthouse as well as spectacular coastal views.
