Day 1: *Itinerary*

- Drive to Edmonton, the capital city of Alberta located on the North Saskatchewan River. A cultural, governmental and educational centre, it is famous for boasting the largest mall in North America and for hosting festivals year-round.
- Guided tour of the Legislature Building, home to the Legislative Assembly of British Columbia. Learn about the province's history, parliamentary process and the architecture of the surprising heritage building.
- Interactive activity specific to your group - ie. Music clinic, language workshop, international cooking class.
- Lunch at an outdoor food market or local food truck (included).
- Entrance to the Telus World of Science, where curiosity and active learning are encouraged and celebrated. Take part in a fun DIY experiment to learn about a scientific phenomenon.
- Choose one of the following options at the West Edmonton Mall:
 - Water Park
 - Galaxyland (students can decide on-site).
 - Blacklight mini golf.
