- Art in the City; Eco-lution; Urban Geography; Media on the Streets; Kensington Market Scavenger Hunt; Waterfront.
- Interactive activity specific to your group ie. Music clinic, language workshop, international cooking class.
- Lunch at an outdoor food market or local food truck.
- Entrance to the half a kilometer-high CN Tower to enjoy a spectacular panorama of the city.
- Guided tour of the Royal Ontario Museum. Challenge your students to practice their critical thinking and collaboration skills through the discovery of artifacts and interactive sensory experiences in labs.
- Drive back to your school at the end of the afternoon/early evening.
- Optional: Add a medieval dinner and show! Enjoy a 4-course medieval feast while watching an incredible 2-hour long tournament between the Knights of the Realm on their horses.
