Day 1: **Arrival Day**

- Drive or fly to Montreal, the 375 years old city is the second largest primarily French-speaking city in world and a hub for Canadian culture and history.
- Entrance to Montreal Tower, the world tallest inclined tower. Enjoy a spectacular view of Montreal and the St Lawrence River.
- Welcome dinner

Day 2: **Montreal**

- Breakfast.
- Walking tour of Old Montreal, the historic neighbourhood of the city.
- Visit of Notre Dame Basilica, a jewels of Quebec's rich religious heritage.
- Visit of Pointe-a-Calliere. This museum of archaeology and history was built on the birthplace of Montreal and offers an original underground circuit through excavations.
- Group dinner.

Day 3: **Montreal**

- Breakfast.
- Free time in Park Mount Royal. Visit Sir George-Etienne Cartier Monument and hike up to Mont Royal lookout for a great view and photo opportunity.
- Entrance to Centre d'Histoire de Montreal Museum, for a 90-minute guided tour through Quebec's history.
- Group dinner and musical show.

- Guided tour of Fort Chambly National Historic Site, a strategic fort built in 1665. Tour the impressive stone fortification and take part in interactive activities.
- Educational program at the Fur Trade at Lachine National Historic Site. Learn about Indigenous trappers, French Canadian voyageurs and European merchants during the fur trade era.
- Farewell Dinner.
